The Centre for Policy Dialogue (CPD), Bangladesh and the Institute of Policy Studies of Sri Lanka (IPS), in partnership with Southern Voice, will host a webinar today focused on solutions to the challenges that the COVID-19 pandemic has created in apparel-supplying countries, in particular Bangladesh and Sri Lanka.
